- 1. Attendance and participation in Huddles
 - Sundays at 12:30 @The Barn at RiverTree Lake
 - Happens twice a month during the school year.
 - Dates are given over the summer when they apply- mark your calendars for the year now so there are no surprises
- 2. Social Media
 - Student leaders are required to only have one social media account per app. This means no fake or spam accounts
 - Be a positive influence while on social media, in how you dress, your words and your actions
 - If at any point posts begin to be questionable, a meeting will be set up to address social media behavior.
- 3. Serving weekly at NRG or FUSE
 - NRG requires arrival at 6PM for set-up and stay until 9PM for clean-up
 - Servant heart and attitude helping with whatever role is needed
 - Co-lead a D-group of middle school students
- 4. Serving on middle school trips as leaders
 - RUOK Middle School Fall Retreat

Policies

- 1. Your son or daughter will be able to miss two Huddles if needed during the school year.
 - If they are unable to attend, they need to text ISAAC SMAGLINSKI @ 330.417.3286 ASAP and let him know.
 - If more than 2 huddles have been missed, we will set up a meeting with student, parent and Isaac to determine is student leadership is a fit for them in the season and if they are able to continue to serve in the capacity.

2. Weekly

- We understand that big school projects/tests, illness or family emergencies, and an occasional sporting obligation may come up from time to time and we are ok with that. However, this needs to be the exceptions and not the rule.
- Your son or daughter needs to text Isaac and the adult leader they are serving with and let them know ASAP so we can be sure that their D-group is covered and any additional areas they were leading are covered as well.
- If your son or daughter is overly committed in other areas or is not showing up when we are counting on them to lead, we will reach out to you to see what's going on. After discussing, we will make a decision to see if it is in your son or daughter's best interest and our team's best interest if they continue on as a leader at this time.
