PHILIPPIANS: Finding Joy in Christ

For most of us, our natural tendency is to live a life in pursuit of happiness. The problem is, we mostly look for happiness in things other than God, and not only that, but our imperfect lives, relationships, and circumstances stop us from finding lasting happiness. The book of Philippians tells us a different story. It tells us that God wants us to experience true joy. This joy cannot be taken, because it isn't based on circumstances, but based on knowing Jesus Christ.

July 1 / Our Trials and God's Glory

READ / Philippians 1:12-18

REFLECT / What is Paul going through? Why does he still rejoice? What does this say about the trials we go through? Are you going through any trials right now? In what ways could God be glorified in your situation?

July 8 / Trusting God in Life or Death

READ / Philippians 1:19-26

REFLECT / What is Paul hoping will happen? What are his thoughts about dying? In what ways is this different than we usually think? Why is Paul still rejoicing and hopeful? In what ways can this encourage you?

July 15 / The Gospel-Shaped Life

READ / Philippians 1:27-30

REFLECT / What do you think a "life worthy of the gospel" looks like? Would you say that you are "striving" in your faith journey? Would you consider yourself "all in?" In what ways does your life need to change or look different?

July 22 / Walking in the Way of Jesus

READ / Philippians 2:1-11

REFLECT / What type of behavior does Paul say believers should be showing? Is this easy or difficult? Do you try to live this way? How does this connect to the life and example of Jesus? What was the model that he gave us?

July 29 / Bright Lights in a Dark World

READ / Philippians 2:12-18

REFLECT / Paul says that we work on ourselves, and God works in us. In what ways are you working on your life to look more like Christ? What behaviors does Paul say help us "shine as lights?" What do you think that means?
