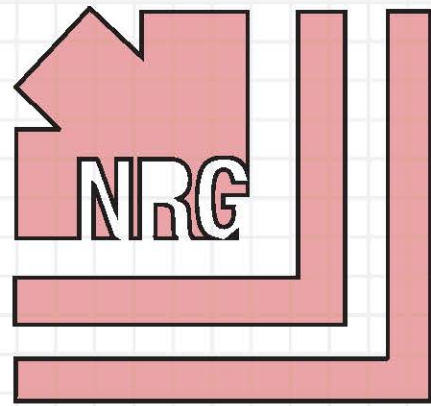
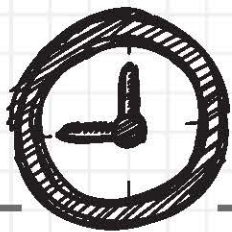


10 Things

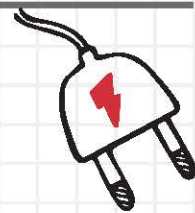

Students can purchase snacks (most cost only \$1) and can purchase T-shirts and other merchandise.

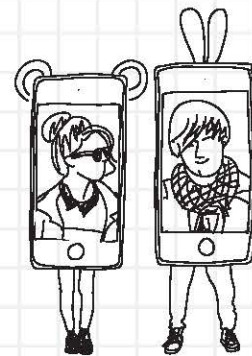
7. *House of Eli*
