

# WILDSIDE Packing List

- Sleeping bag/pillow - Please make sure that you clearly label them.
- Pack a set of clothes that can get muddy and wet. This should include closed toes shoes that can get wet. A white t-shirt - dark one will get muddy, white one will be "colored" during a color war.
- Comfy clothes - shorts, t-shirts, etc
- Outfit for theme night
- 3 pairs of shoes - One closed-toed (tennis shoes). One open-toed (sandals). One pair that can get muddy and wet.
- Bathing Suit - OK....So here's the scoop on suits... Guys- Just bring normal boxer-like suits. Girls- We prefer you wear a one-piece or tankini. If you don't have that, it's ok. You don't have to buy one, but please bring an extra solid-color t-shirt to wear over your suit.
- 2 Towels - one for shower and one for swimming
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste/Deodorant/Soap
- Sunscreen - being sunburned is not a recipe for fun
  
- Snack to share in your room. Always good to have a snack.
- Spending \$ - In labeled envelope with name and have this ready to turn in at check in. DO NOT pack this in your luggage! Cash or Checks (payable to RiverTree).
- How much spending money do we need? We suggest \$60-70.
- **Snack Bar:** At the snack bar we will serve candy, pop, bottle water, sports drinks, hot dogs, nachos and some other snacks. All food items are \$1-2 each so a \$3 per day allotment for a drink and snack is a good indicator. Also available at the snack bar are camp t-shirts for \$18, tank tops for \$18, Hats for \$18 and sunglasses and strong bags for \$5, and make and take crafts for \$1 each.
- **Auction:** This has become one of the highlights of camp each year. We suggest that students bring \$20-25 for this. This is a fantastic way to have fun and also change lives. We will auction off all sorts of items that students can bid on individually or as a group or cabin. It is a lot of fun and students love bidding on some of the crazy stuff we offer. Each year we donate the proceeds of the auction to support and bless a non-profit ministry.
- Garbage bag for wet/dirty clothes
- Flashlight - because you never know
- Bug Spray - It's nice to have
- Prescription & Over the Counter Medications - These need to be in their original bottles and placed in a zip-lock baggie with student's name on it. These will be handed in during check-in before we get on the bus. The Camp Nurse will take care of it from there.
