- Bible, Notebook, Pen
- Refillable water bottle with name on it
- String Bag- it will be helpful for carrying stuff around camp (water bottle, towel, sun screen, etc. or bible, notebook, pen)
- Sleeping bag and pillow clearly marked with name
- Plain white t-shirt to get "colored" during the color war
- Theme night out-fit- Alien, Sci-fi, Outer Space- no need to go out and buy an expensive outfit-you can get creative with aluminum foil, duct tape, sunglasses, head band, green face paint, etc.- it's just a fun night getting dressed up with your cabin.
- 3 pair of shoes (sandals- beach/shower, tennis shoes (every day), messy shoes for color war)
- Bathing Suit- ok- here's the scoop on suits: Guys- just bring normal boxer like suits. Girls- we prefer you wear a one-piece or tankini. If you don't have one, that's ok. Please bring a dark colored t-shirt to wear over your bikini.
- 2 towels- One for showering and one for swimming
- Garbage bag for wet/dirty clothes
- Toothbrush/toothpaste/deodorant/soap/hair brush
- Sunscreen/bug spray
- Flashlight
- Spending money has 3 forms (snack bar, apparel, and auction money). Please put the total of these 3 things in an envelope with your son or daughters name on it and have it ready to turn in at check in. DO NOT pack this in their luggage. Cash or checks made payable to RiverTree. Each student will have an "account" set up with these funds and deductions will be made from their purchases and auction contribution. We suggest \$50-\$60 total but whatever amount you decide is totally fine. Please note that any money given will not be refunded. It must be spent or will be donated. See breakdown below:
 - Snack Bar \$: At the camp store, we sell candy, pop, bottled water, sports drinks, hot dogs, nachos and some other snacks. All food items are \$1-\$2 so a \$3 per day allotment for a drink and snack is a good amount (\$15 for the week)
 - Apparel and Activities \$: Camp T-shirts are \$18, Sun-glasses and string bags are \$5. Make and Take crafts are \$1 each. (A shirt, sunglasses and 2 crafts- \$25)
 - Auction \$: This has become one of the highlights of camp each year. We suggest that students plan on \$20 for the auction. The auction is a fantastic way to have fun together as a cabin and change lives. Students love bidding on some of the crazy and fun experiences we offer. Each year we donate the proceeds of the auction to bless a non-profit ministry.
- Prescription and over the counter Medications- these need to be in their original bottles and placed in a ziplock baggie with the student's name on it. **These will be turned in during check-in before we get on the bus. DO NOT PACK MEDS in luggage.** The Camp Nurse will take care of it from there.
- Things **NOT** to bring: electronics/phones, energy drinks/pop, body sprays (Axe or perfume).
